Vinification

The harvest is done by hand – pressing is carefully undertaken with pneumatic presses. Fermentation temperature is controlled by cooling. Each grape is vinified separately before blending.

Tasting notes

This wine has a clear yellow colour with a fruity and harmonious aroma. The palate is supple and well balanced. The taste contains juicy white peach flavors, with some apricot nuances, a touch of lime and some spice on the finish. This is an easy to drink wine.

Best to drink:

Minimal ageing potential.

Wine pairing:

Great as an aperitif, as well as with all kind of Asian foods, fish, chicken and pasta dishes.
