

After being carefully gone over by hand on a sorting table, the grapes undergo a long maceration in temperature-controlled vats. The wine is matured for 18 months in air-conditioned cellars, 80% in oak barrels, a third of which are renewed each year, and 20% in vats.

Tasting notes

The Lalande de Pomerol of Château Garraud possesses an intense ruby color; this elegant wine evolves towards a deep red-orange. The nose expresses great aromatic complexity, dominated by red fruits and smooth oak. On the palate it is fleshy, velvety and lush with a long finish.

Best to drink:

Between 5 and 15 years

This wine can be enjoyed with beef, lamb or chicken.
