Vinification

Maceration of grapes in stainless steel vats for 1 month, followed by 100% alcoholic and malolactic fermentations. Maturing on fine lees for 18 to 24 months.

Tasting notes

This wine has a nice deep color with a beautiful aromatic maturity. The aroma is a perfect combination of red fruits (cherry) associated with black fruits (blueberry). The taste is both dense and generous and the tannic structure is supple. It finishes with a pleasant cherry and spice tasting.

Best to drink

Good aging from 5 to 10 years

Wine pairing:

Beef carpaccio, roasted rack of lamb with thyme, beef rib with candied shallots, blue cheese
