

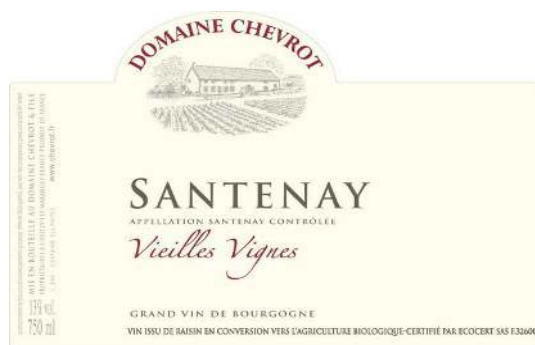

Vinification

Manual harvesting. Alcoholic fermentation: 15 days of vatting - only punched (5 total) - 15 to 34 ° C.
Malolactic fermentation. Ageing: 15 months French oak barrels of 228 l - 3 rackings -15% new oak barrels

Tasting notes

The bouquet of our Santenay combines the mineral character of its original terroir with candied black fruits, cinnamon and the complex fragrances of iris. The taste is of an exceptional density which deploys its black fruits with elegance. Vinification with 50% whole bunches brings a full finish, structured by a grain of fine tannins.
