

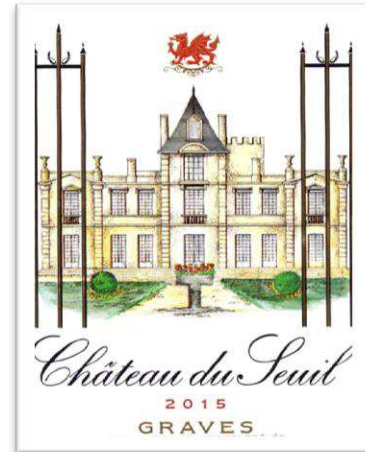
# CHATEAU DU SEUIL

## Technical information

**Country:** France  
**Region:** Bordeaux  
**Appellation:** Graves  
**Grape Variety :** Majority of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot with a small percent of Cabernet Franc  
**Terroir :** Terrace of river gravel and sand deposits with subsoil limestone, clay, iron pan  
**Age of the vines :** average 35 years



## Vinification

Pressed pneumatically, preferment maceration of 5 days. Alcohol fermentation in tank, and post ferment maceration up to 3 weeks. Malolactic fermentation in tank and barrels. 20% of wine aged for 16 months in new French oak, 70% in 1, 2 and 3 year old oak.

## Tasting notes

Very expressive on the nose, with red fruits, soft supple tannins and a harmonious finish.

1 to 3 years

Enjoyable with white and red meat.
