Vinification

Total de-stemming, vinification and maceration between 25 and 40 days; temperature controlled. Pressing and selection of wines. Malolactic fermentation in vat. Ageing: Exclusively free run wine, 90% of the blend is aged in new barrels for about 12 months +8 months in vats. Racking every two months. Fining, filtering and bottling.

Tasting notes

Intense color, nose of red berries with hint of coffee & spice. Rich structure & great aromatic expression on the palate. Fine & elegant with ageing potential, complex.
