Grape Variety : 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Malbec
Terroir : Cabernet; a vineyard planted on a rather steep hill, with no terraces. Little to no work done and irrigation is kept to a minimum. Malbec from Altamira.
Age of the vines : 20 years



Vinification

100% aged in french oak and rested in bottle for 24 months before market release.

Tasting notes

Dense purple core with a lighter rim. Intense nose, some evolution and layers; fine oak, roasted coffee, sweet dark fruit, cassis, tobacco and spice box. The palate is medium bodied with rounded extract, fresh with mint, sage and some herbal notes and crushed dark berries. Good length and flavour intensity in a more classic style.

Best to drink:

This wine will keep for 10 years.

Wine pairing:

Goes well with beef, veal, lamb, goat, and any other well seasoned meat.
