Vinification

Our grapes are sorted according to their maturity and health status. Cold pre-fermentation maceration that gives the wine good structure. The fermentation lasts two weeks between 68 to 82° F. Regular pumping over releases the power of the tannins and the coloring. We raise the wine about 18 months, in oak barrels.

Tasting notes

This is a of deep red wine. The aroma will distinguish the ripe fruit which is grilled and woody. The powerful taste has a complex expression and well typed mourvèdre.
